PARISH CEMETERY

List of fees pursuant to Section 214 of the Local Government Act 1972. The payments come into force on 1 October 2017

Part 1 Internment

Fee for the internment of a body	£200
Fee for the internment of cremated remains	£100

Part 2 Monuments

Standard low plinth monument in any stone

£ 60

Vases may be placed on the grave temporarily until the headstone is erected (usually within 12 months). When the headstone is erected, vases can be placed on the grave but they should only stand on the plinth incorporated in the headstone. No glass or plastic ornaments are to be placed anywhere else as these shatter if contractors using power tools do not see them.

£ 40

Slate is best avoided as it can be scratched by strimmers

The Parish Council regrets it is unable to take responsibility for headstones and plaques when placed.

Part 3 Exclusive Right of Burial

For the exclusive right of burial in the next available plot in an earthen grave 8'6" x 4'3"

Upon the first death the next adjoining plot will be left available for the partner without a reservation charge.

- The middle plot will be used first from No 1 in order.
- Cremation plots will be alphabetical starting from (a)
- Reservations will be the decision of the Parish Council
- Graves one depth only may be interned on top.
- No ashes to be scattered within the Burial Ground
